Gordon Brazil to Mary Slayter Mar. License State of Louisiana Parish of Ouachita To Any Ordained minister of the Gospel domicilated within the parish and State aforesaid or to any Justice of the Peace legally authorized according to law, to celebrate marriages within the same place greetings.

You are hereby authorized and empowered to unite in the Bonds of matrimony and holy wedlock Mr. Gordon Brazil and inhabitant of the State of Arkansas and Miss Mary Slayter resident of said Parish and State and to solominize and celebrate the said marriage between the parties as above named according to the laws and customs of the State of Louisiana and make your return hereof as the law directs and this is your authority for so doing.
