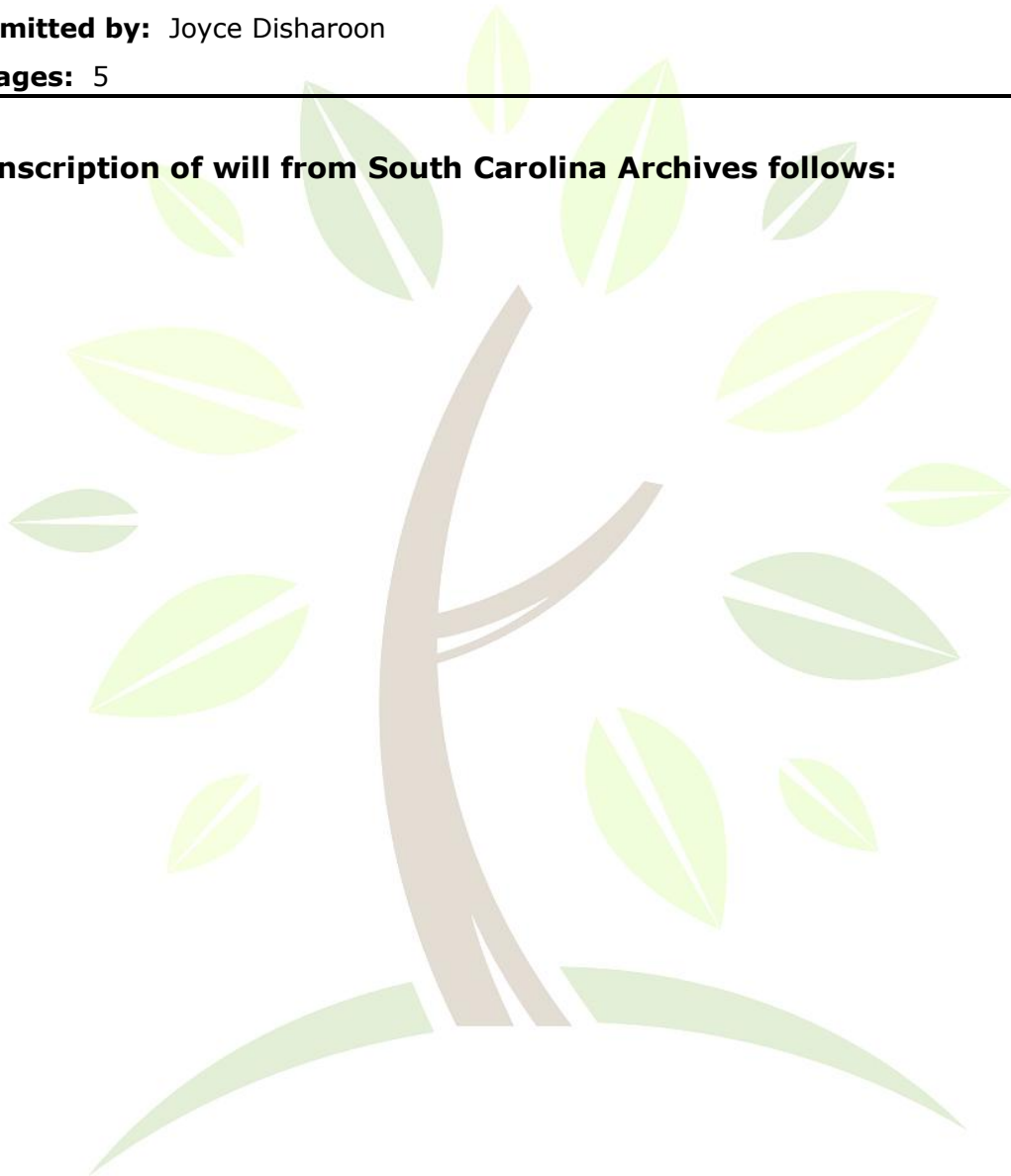

## WILL OF

WILLIS BREAZEALE

In the name of God Amen, I Willis Breazeale Sen<sup>r</sup> of the State of South Carolina in the County of Abbeville Being in perfect health of body and of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto <sup>God</sup> God, Cawling unto Mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die Do make and ordain This my last will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul Into the hand of almighty <sup>God</sup> God that gave it and my body I Recosmend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the descretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive The same by the mighty power of god And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to blessme in this life I give demise and dispose of the Same in the following manner and form First I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah the sum of twenty five pounds Sterling money during her widowhood and prudent behaviour as als my Negrow garl to wait upon her During her prudent behaviour the negroes name is Cissoe Also my beloved sons Misha Breazeale I give and bequeath my Negrow woman Named Cate as also her Daughter Named Cissoe by him and the heirs of his boddy freely to be possessed and Injoyed forever But if the

said Elisha Breakeale should decease leaving no Such heir as  
above mentioned that then the Said Negrows Shall Revert to and  
belong properly to Benjamin Frankling Breakeale my son, But if  
said Benjimin Frankling Breakeale Should Decease before he shall  
have heirs or heirs lawfully begotten that then the fore Named  
Negrow Shall Revert to and belong to Kinsman Breakeale and  
Archabald Breakeale and their heirs lawfully betotten Also to my  
beloved Son Benjamin Frankling Breakeale I give and beaueath  
the plantation or tract of land were on I now dwell Containing  
two hundred acres By him and his heirs freely to possed that is  
to Say the heirs of his body lawfully begotten but if he Decease  
without an heir lawfully betotten that then Said land shall  
Rever unto his younger brothers kinsman Breakeale and Archabald  
Breakeale with all and singuler the houses orchards fencing  
wa rters and water courses Also to my three Sons Drury Willis and  
Elijah Breakeale I give to Mach one of them the Sum of one  
Shilling Sterling if the Same Shall be lawfully demanded as also

to my three Daughters <sup>M</sup>ary Sarah and patty Breascales I give to  
 Ea ch one of the the sum of one shilling Sterling if the same  
 shall be lawfully demanded the Residue and Remainder of my Estate  
 if any there should be after my lawful Debts is paid I give and  
 beq ueath to my sons George Washington Benjaminin Frankling  
 Kinsemin A rohabald Breascales that is to say the Remainder of  
 my lands live's Stook house hold furniture plantation Tooles  
 Books and book debts Bonds bills notes of hand moneys &c to be  
 equally Divided amongst them Also to my old Negrow woman Named  
 Newcorer I give and beq ueath her freedom to be no longer a  
 servent after my decea se also my will is that my Executors do not  
 let said old Negrow Suffer Nither For food or <sup>M</sup>anent whilst my  
 Estate is Sufficent to Support her also the money bequeathed to  
 Sarah My wife if she should Behave imprudent or keep a disorderly  
 house after my Decease is to be Taken from her and Equally  
 divided between my four youngest sons by her begotten and I do  
 Hereby Constitute make and ordain y Beloved Brothers Drury  
 Breascale Sen<sup>r</sup> and my Son Elisha Breascale and Sarah Breascale  
 my wife the whole and sole Executors and Executrix of this my

last will and testament and I do hereby utterly disallow Revoake  
and disanull all and Every other former testaments wills, legacies  
bequests and Executors or Executrix by me in anywise before named  
will and beq ueathed Ratifying and Confurming this and No  
other to be my last will and Testament in Witness whereof I have  
unto set my hand and seal this Sixth day of November in the  
year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and Mintey four  
Signed Sealed Published Pronounced and declared By the said  
Willis Breaxcale Sen<sup>r</sup>.as his last will And Testament in the  
presents of us Who in his presents And in the presents of Each  
other have hereunto Subscribed our names
